This summer has truly been an unusual, stressful, and tiresome one. I hope you were able to find rest in Christ during all the goings on. As we look forward to the Fall, here at APC we want don't want to shut down and cease doing ministry. Things will be different, that is for sure, but things will not stop. To that end, here's what you can expect to see in September.

Due to the pandemic, we cut out all unison readings and corporate singing in worship. As we continue to be diligent in our precautions, we can begin reintroducing some of these elements, which so many of us have missed dearly. Starting Sunday, September 6, we will add back the unison Prayer of Confession and the Lord's Prayer. Let me remind you, if adding these elements makes you uncomfortable or weary, it is totally acceptable to participate in the recorded service from home. We will continue to record our services just as we had long before the pandemic.

For those who participated in the last year's Bible study video series on the attributes of God will recall that the speaker was Dr. Steven Lawson, whom I studied under in a seminar back in February. Well, I will once again get to participate in another conference of his on September 14-16 in Richmond entitled "Preaching with Precision and Power." Because of this conference, our weekly events will resume after I get back.

The weekly Tuesday morning Bible Study will reconvene September 22 at 10:00 AM. For health and safety reasons, we will meet in the sanctuary, to better allow for social distancing. Moreover, the Bible study will be recorded, since our camera is in the sanctuary, and will be posted online Friday mornings (in lieu of the weekend Bible studies during the summer). This fall I will lead us through the deep waters of Reformed theology.

Long before the pandemic started, a vision of mine was to have more opportunities for involvement in the life the church. Consequently, we will start a Wednesday evening gathering. This gathering will look different each Wednesday, but will be an opportunity to fellowship and worship in a more casual setting. The first gathering will be September 23 at 6:30 PM.

Related to the previous change, the Youth Group will begin meeting weekly, rather than twice a month. The youth will meet every Sunday evening, starting September 13, only this time we will rotate our meeting place. Though, our first meeting will be at 5:00 PM at the church.

These increases in frequency are to help us all better establish habits of spiritual nourishment. As we think missionally—thinking of ways we can better impact the community around us—we need to offer ways to connect and grow more than just Sunday mornings. My hope is to get into a rhythm for small group ministry and midweek worship.
