Lent is in full swing and Easter is just around the corner. We are seasonally situated in my expository series on the *Gospel of Mark*. Depending on who you ask, Mark wrote either 15 or 16 chapters to his Gospel of Jesus Christ. One third of this book is dedicated to the last week of Jesus' life! Indeed, this year I will wrap up this series, so it seems fitting that we get to spend an entire year (minus summer—but more on that in a later article) on Holy Week!

Traditionally, Lent is the 40 days before Easter and Holy Week—for obvious reasons—is the week between Palm Sunday and Resurrection Sunday. But 40 days is hardly enough time to digest the fullness that is Holy Week. Therefore, we are blessed to take the time to stroll through the teachings of Mark's Gospel.

I am also pleased to note that the various Bible study groups are going well. The Bible is the foundational document, not only for our theology, but also for our very lives. In this book, God has breathed out his plan and his will. I am very excited and honored to continue to share with you the inestimable value of God's Word. My hope is to encouraged more of you to become engaged with Scripture. This pandemic has changed the way we interact with people—sometimes for ill, sometimes for good—but it can never change the way we interact with God. For the time being, I will continue to post recordings of studies that take place in the sanctuary. But I strongly urge each of you to consider coming to a mid-week study. And I am in the process of discerning more opportunities for discipleship. So, if something doesn't fit your schedule now, definitely let me know and be on the lookout for other things in the near future. I consider it a great privilege to be your pastor and want to continue to honor my pledge and my call to serve you.



Pastor Ed will be on family leave March 8-27. No studies will be offered at that time.


Youth Group — Mar. 7th & 28th

Bible Study continues in Reformed theology by studying the *Westminster Confession of Faith*.


Bible101 — Feb. 1st & 29th
